**PLAINTIFFS’ MOTION FOR ATTORNEYS’ FEES,
EXPENSES, AND SERVICE AWARDS**

On February 26, 2026, the Court preliminarily approved a proposed class action settlement (the “Settlement,” “Settlement Agreement,” or “SA”)¹ between Defendant Anne Arundel Dermatology, P.A. (“Defendant”) and Plaintiffs,² on behalf of themselves, and on behalf of the Settlement Class (ECF No. 40) (the “Preliminary Approval Order”).³ Pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement, and the Court’s Preliminary Approval Order, Class Counsel respectfully request the Court award: (i) reasonable attorneys’ fees in the amount of \$800,000.00 (one-third of the Settlement Fund); (ii) litigation expenses in the amount of \$25,226.98; and (iii) Service Awards in the amount of \$1,500.00 to each Class Representative.

As set forth in the accompanying Memorandum of Law, these requests are reasonable,

³ The Preliminary Approval Order provides that Plaintiffs’ Motion for Attorneys’ Fees, Expenses, and Services Awards must be filed no later than June 1, 2026. However, the Settlement Agreement provides that any request for attorneys’ fees, expenses, and service awards must be filed with the Court at least twenty-one (21) days before the Objection Deadline. (SA, ¶¶ 6.1–6.2). According to the Preliminary Approval Order, the Objection Deadline is June 9, 2026. Thus, Plaintiffs file this Motion in accordance with the earlier deadline proscribed in the Settlement Agreement.

appropriate, and mirror approved requests in similar data privacy cases. Therefore, Plaintiffs' Motion for Attorneys' Fees, Expenses, and Service Awards should be GRANTED.
